Very important to read this instruction and information page before installing your new view thru window graphic.

Important note: See Thru Window Films are not to be applied to windshield or front side glass ( Drive or passenger doors.) Check with your local laws about rear window applications.

Make sure the outside air temp. is a min. of 40dg.F. Glass temp. can be raised by running vehicle with heat on inside.

Prep. your glass. This step is very important! It's recommended to wash the glass first with a soap and water mixture, to remove bugs and tree sap. You can clean it again with glass cleaner. Make sure the glass is dry before installing the graphic.

Laying out the graphic: Lay the graphic out on the window and use masking tape to keep it in position. You will need to tape in the corners and middle. Make sure the graphic's image is placed where you want it on the glass and make sure the graphic covers all areas of the glass.

Remove masking tape from one side only and start removing the backing from the graphics. Lay the graphics back over the other side with the sticky side up. Cut the backing paper away at about 12" or so back. Bring the graphic over and start applying to window. Smooth out any wrinkles with your hand. You can lift the graphic back off the glass to remove wrinkles. Now un-tape the rest of the graphic. Lay it back over the side that's down. Start by removing the backing at the end near the already adhered section. Slowly pull the backing and apply the graphic as it is removed.

After the backing is removed and the graphic is applied wrinkle free. Tack a piece of the backing and place over the outside of the graphic and rub firmly with a squeegee, this will prevent from scratching the graphic.

Use a razor blade to trim excess film around edges of the glass. If installing on a slider window, trim between panels. Let sit 24 -36 hours before sliding glass.

Care of graphic: Do not power wash or car wash for at least one week. Rear wipers will wear graphic prematurely. Note that water will collect in holes after washing or rain and will distort vision.
